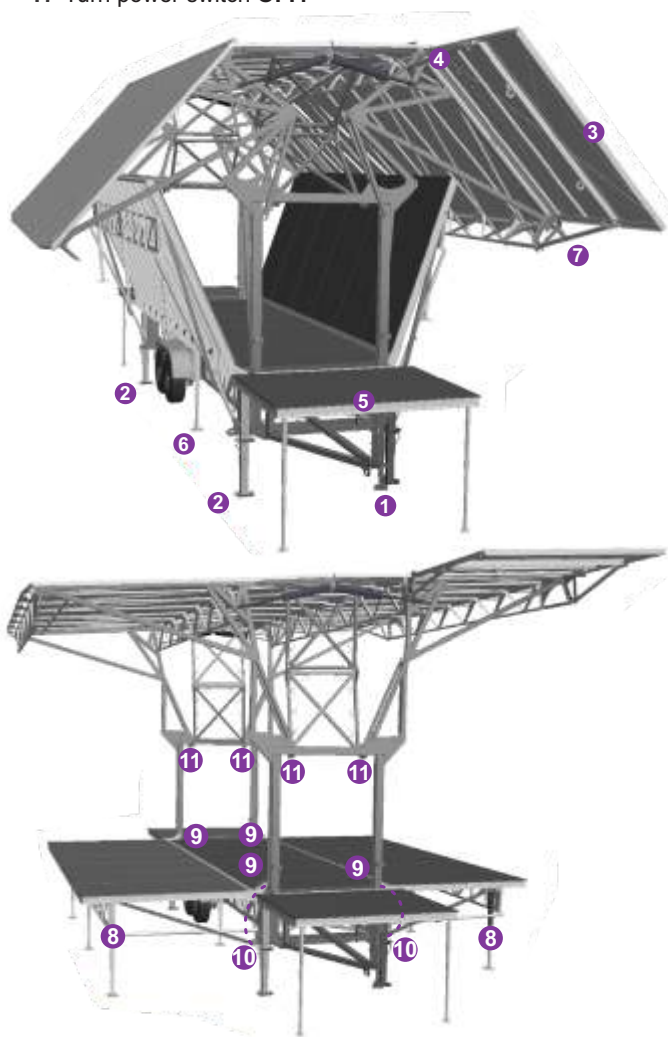


Quick Guide

Stage Setup

- 1 Position stage and disconnect tow vehicle.
- 2 Verify area is clear of obstacles, wires, and people.
- 3 Release flybay door latches and open doors.
- 4 Level trailer frame lengthwise using tongue jack.
- 5 Turn control box power switch timer **ON**
- 6 Extend (4) corner jacks and level trailer.
- 7 If equipped, lower monitor-mix decks.
- 8 Using controller - open canopy approximately 24" (60 cm).
- 9 Install lower flybay support bars and pin.
- 10 Lower & secure trailer mid-frame leveling/support jacks.
- 11 Open stage until lowest deck corner is slightly below center deck level. Extend corner jack foot to ground contact. Repeat for other (3) deck corners.
- 12 Remove canopy/deck linkage pins and install pins in diagonal deck braces (4) places.
- 13 Adjust deck truss leveling/support jacks until pins are snug.
- 14 Lower & secure deck mid-truss support jacks.
- 15 Fully raise canopy and pin bars - (4) places.
- 16 Double-check all connections. Make sure all jacks are securely planted.
- 17 Turn power switch **OFF**.



Stage Closing

- 1 Remove all attached accessories - stairs, rails, windwalls, etc.
- 2 Open control box - Turn power switch timer **ON**.
- 3 Remove and store canopy lock pins - (4) places.
- 4 Remove deck brace pins, install in vertical links Four (4) places.
- 5 Retract deck truss leveling/support jacks.
- 6 Using controller, lower canopy to 12" from closed.
- 7 Retract mid-frame jacks.
- 8 Remove and store flybay lower support bars and pins - (2) ends.
- 9 Fully close canopy
- 10 Attach cargo tie-down straps.
- 11 Raise & secure monitor-mix platforms if equipped
- 12 Close and latch flybay doors - (2) ends.
- 13 If folded - pivot and pin (2) hitch sections.
- 14 Extend tongue jack.
- 15 Retract corner leveling/support jacks - (4) places.
- 16 Connect to tow vehicle - hitch, safety chains, electrical.

Canopy Mounted Equipment Installation

- 1 Remove roof lock bar pins and lower canopy.
Note - Minimum of 6ft (1.8m) distance between bottom bar of truss and stage deck when lifting equipment.
- 2 Install equipment (windwalls, banners, speakers, lights) following canopy loading limitations.
- 3 Fully open stage canopy.
- 4 Install canopy lock bar pins (4) places.
- 5 Turn power timer switch to **OFF**.
- 6 Note - Additional canopy mounted equipment may be winched into position - follow canopy loading limitations.

CAUTIONS

- Discontinue Set Up - lower canopy 40 mph (64 kph)
- Remove Windwalls/Backdrops 30 mph (48 kph)
Pull quick-release handle(s)
Lower speakers to ground level
- Remove Banners 30 mph (48 kph)
Remove canopy lock-bar pins - (4) places
Lower roof canopy
Remove banners
- Maximum Stage Wind Capacity 80 mph (128 kph)*
* Roof Canopy raised and locked
* No windwall/backdrops or banners attached
- Evacuate personnel a minimum 40 mph (64 kph)
of 100ft (30m) from stage
